Ergoform Ltd is doing everything possible, both during the manufacturing process and at end of product life, to ensure that any component used, and also component packaging, is recycled.

We realise that to achieve this, we need to enlist the help and co-operation of our customers.

If you are sitting on an ergoform chair, or have ergoform chairs in your offices, when they reach the end of their working life, please do not send them to the Landfill.

Phone us and we can arrange to have them picked up and returned for recycling.

Currently, on average, over 90% of the componentry of all chairs manufactured by Ergoform Ltd is able to be recycled and, more importantly, is being recycled.

All of this is part of ergoforms determination to be as environmentally responsible as possible.

Of course, this also means being careful to ensure that as much as possible of what is used in the manufacturing process is recycled and not sent to landfill.

To this end, all of the cardboard and plastics from the packaging of components is recycled, as is any metal and foam that is not used in the actual manufacture of a chair.

Thank you for taking the time to read this, and please remember that for only the cost of freight, and one phone call, we can all make a very real difference.

Please note that there are available a number of sustainable, recycled, recyclable, or biodegradable / compostable fabric coverings which, if used, may further increase the component recyclable content and percentage.

As well as the finished product, all of the cardboard and plastics from the packaging of components is recycled, as is any metal and foam not used in the actual manufacture of a chair.

PRODUCT STEWARDSHIP / RECYCLING / REFURBISHING

Ergoform has in place a product stewardship policy which enables us to recycle / refurbish our products at end of life.

When your ergoform chairs reach the end of their working life, please do not send them to the landfill.

Phone ergoform for new chairs, and arrange to have your old chairs picked up and returned for recycling.

Some models of ergoform chairs can also be refurbished, so ask if that is an option for you.

We realise that to achieve our goal of complete product sustainability, we need to enlist the help and co-operation of our customers.

We have put in place systems to inform our customers of the importance of returning the product for recycling, or refurbishment.

Please remember that for only the cost of freight, and one phone call, we can have your chairs picked up and recycled and make a very real difference.
